## What is The Four Leaf Clover Club?

We are a registered mental health charity in Sherborne providing support and information. Our project aims to involve the whole community in all the clubs activities.

## Where is it?

The Clubhouse is centrally situated in 1, Abbey Road, just off Cheap Street, next to NatWest Bank.

## Who does it help?

We work specifically in the field of mental health. Our members are recovering from various problems and need a safe community venue to meet and engage in meaningful activity, which can include education, training and socialising.

## Zest Café



Zest Café is our popular social enterprise which runs every Friday and Saturday as a community internet café. The emphasis is on healthy living. Our menu includes fresh juices and smoothies as well as soup, jacket potatoes and toasted sandwiches. We offer trainee opportunities for members and also people from the wider community. The café is a colourful and vibrant setting to eat, drink and use the internet and we also employ people in a paid capacity in addition to offering many opportunities for voluntary work.

## Why do we need your help?

We have a large financial outlay in order to manage our premises and pay our staff. Due to our central location we pay a high level of rent and we have considerable expenses associated with the maintenance of the building. There is also the need to fund consistently various projects, including the production of our quarterly magazine, Brainwaves.

## A resource for the community

We have three internet enabled computers which are available for use by members of the public throughout the week. We can also accommodate laptop users with wi-fi. Every Thursday morning the First Dorset Credit Union uses our venue to give advice on savings and low cost loans. We are able to help members of the public who are interested in finding out more information about mental health issues and our charitable work in general. This may involve the accessing of voluntary and training opportunities at the Clubhouse.

## What can we offer you?

If you are a business or individual, we can offer a reduced rate for private hire of our premises, a reduced advertising rate in Brainwaves magazine, which is widely distributed in Dorset and 30 minutes free wi-fi/internet use throughout the week.

## Are there other ways you can help us?

There are a number of other ways you can help and support us. For example, holding a jumble sale, donating the proceeds of an auction or holding an Open Garden day. There are the additional possibilities of making private donations or leaving a legacy to us in your will, which we have benefited from in the past.
